International Students no longer required to pay fees in advance.

Guy Pearson, Managing Director of Pearson Aviation announced today that International students newly enrolling into one of Pearson Aviation's pilot training courses will no longer be required to pay fees in advance.

Mr Pearson stated that subject to a written legal agreement Pearson Aviation will accept students into their Certificate IV (Commercial Pilot) and Diploma (Instrument Flight Operations) courses without a requirement to pay fees in advance.
